Participant Responsibilities

The HGG Leadership Program offers a thoughtfully structured series of eight immersive sessions, each ranging from half-day to full-day experiences (approximately 4 to 8 hours). These sessions are designed to equip participants with essential leadership skills, covering topics such as government at all levels, economic development, nonprofits, civic engagement, political campaigns, and strategic communication. Each cohort will also collaborate on a class project focused on addressing a shared regional challenge in Northeast Indiana. This project serves as a capstone experience, allowing participants to apply insights from the sessions to develop a meaningful, actionable solution.

Because the program is highly selective, **participants are expected to attend and actively engage in all sessions. One excused absence may be permitted** in cases of emergency or prior approval. Sessions will not be recorded, and materials will not be distributed outside of class. To fully benefit from the program, a strong commitment to participation and collaboration is essential.
